


Direct Print & Share



1. Select and Add your printer

2. Add Image

If you open your image and it is grayed out it is because the dimensions do not match the width of the paper in your printer **OR** it is too large of a file.

- 3. In the preview drop down menu, choose Layout.
- 4. Paper Settings
 - Roll paper
 - Choose paper type (Auto may be an option)
 - Roll paper width (either 24in. or 36in.)
- **5. Check "Rotate 90 degrees"** if you would like the long side of your image to fit the width of the paper (this uses up less paper) (If it does not allow you to check this setting, it is because the dimensions of your image cannot be rotated.)
- * If you are printing multiple images in one print job, go to the top right corner button: **Preferences,** and make sure "**Insert blank page between files**" is **Un-checked** and click **OK**

After following these steps, **Print.**
